User anonymity and personal information

Log files are maintained and analysed of all requests for files on this website's web servers. Log files do not capture personal information but do capture the user's IP address, which is automatically recognised by our web servers. Aggregated analysis of these log files is used to monitor website usage. These analyses may be made to available to The Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich staff to allow them to measure, for example, overall popularity of the site and typical user paths through the site.

Except as stated already, The Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich will make no attempt to identify individual users. You should be aware, however, that access to web pages will generally create log entries in the systems of your ISP or network service provider. These entities may be in a position to identify the client computer equipment used to access a page. Such monitoring would be done by the provider of network services and is beyond the responsibility or control of The Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich.

Appendix I: this table below explains the cookies that are used on this site and why.

Cookie Name	Duration	Description
exp_last_activity	1 year	Contains the date of your last activity on the site.
exp_last_visit	1 year	This is only relevant to registered users and contains data relating to the dates of your visits to the site.
exp_tracker	Session (until the browser is closed)	Contains the last 5 pages viewed, encrypted for security. Typically used for form or error message returns.
exp_csrf_token	1 hour	CSRF stands for Cross Site Request Forgery. This cookie is a security enhancement for Expression Engine. Immediately before any forms are sent on the site, this cookie is set. Expression Engine then verifies that the cookie in the browser was the one that it set, therefore confirming the submission from the site is genuine.

_ga	2 years	Included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the site's user reports.
_gat	1 minute	Queues requests sent to Google Analytics.
_gid	24 hours	Holds a unique value to distinguish between users.
