Privacy

User anonymity and personal information Log files are maintained and analysed for all requests for files on this website's web servers. Log files do not capture personal information but do capture the user's IP address, which is automatically recognised by our web servers. Aggregated analysis of these log files is used to monitor website usage. These analyses may be made to available to The Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich staff to allow them to measure, for example, overall popularity of the site and typical user paths through the site. Except as stated already, The Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich will make no attempt to identify individual users. You should be aware, however, that access to web pages will generally create log entries in the systems of your ISP or network service provider. These entities may be in a position to identify the client computer equipment used to access a page. Such monitoring would be done by the provider of network services and is beyond the responsibility or control of The Diocese of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich.

YSC	Stores, tracks and associates user interaction
Consistency	Security cookie – verifies website visitor, strips modified cookies
GPS	Stores location data
Visitor_Info1_live	Provides bandwidth estimations
Pref	Stores user preferences
SOCS	Stores a user's state regarding cookie choices – lasts 13 months
Consent	Stores a user's state regarding cookie choices – lasts 2 years
Laravel	Essential cookie – functionality only

NID	User preferences e.g. language
