Vigil of Hope

A "Vigil of Hope" is being held in Alton's Market Square over the weekend of 30th and 31st October, immediately prior to the start of COP26, the crucially important Climate Conference at Glasgow in early November. It's being led by Alton Climate Action Network (ACAN), in conjunction with the local WI and Parish of the Resurrection. Local churches are being invited to participate, along with other groups such as schools, scouts and guides.

We are hoping for a COGS 'presence' during two separate one hour slots on the morning of Saturday 30th - at 10.00 am, and again at 12.00 midday, and to use the opportunity to engage passers-by in conversation, with prayers, songs and hymns, and other 'fun' activities such as climate board games, and a childrens' art display. Note that this is not a 'protest' or 'campaign' meeting, but simply a time of peace and reflection, and an opportunity for prayer for the best possible outcome from the Summit meeting. It's particularly pertinent that Tearfund happens to be our 'charity of the month'.
