Templecombe Token Certificates



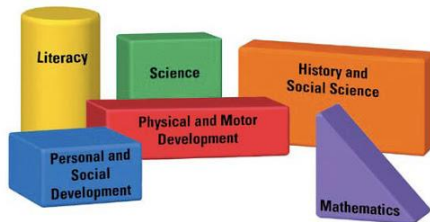
Congratulations go to Isaac and Victoria from Ruby Class for achieving their Silver Templecombe Token certificate this week.
