



Maunday Thursday Plan

- Watch: Resurrection eggs video.
- Activity: Get a bowl of soap and water with towels to dry and wash each other's feet. John 13: 1-17 Talk about Jesus being the King of Israel, but he didn't come to be served like a king he came to serve others. Before the last meal he had with his friend's Jesus took off his outer garment wrapped a towel around his waist, poured water into a bowl and washed his disciple's feet. In Jesus' time the roads were not tarmacked like ours they were stony and dusty. The people at that time wore sandals not shoes, like us and after a day of walking the dusty roads their feet would be dirty and dusty. On entering a person's house, it was a tradition/custom to wash guest's feet. Not doing so would have been disrespectful. Even though Jesus was the son of God the King of Israel he still served his friends by washing their feet. Talk about how you felt about having your feet washed. Its ok if anyone felt uncomfortable. We feel uncomfortable as we are not used to being served with such humility. There is something humbling about washing and having our feet washed.

- Sing: Jesus' love is very wonderful, Wriggle like a worm or Wiggle Freeze from YouTube page.
- Activity: After washing each other's feet you could share some bread and squash.
 Explain that Jesus and his friend's shared bread and wine together for their Passover meal together. The Passover meal is shared every year as a reminder of when God rescued the Israelite's from Egypt. This is where Communion comes from where we share the bread and wine in church together to remember Jesus' and his love for us.
- Craft: Make playdough or air-drying clay together and make some loaves of bread and cups or wine glasses.

- Make: a Last Supper placemat by printing out the template on PDF below. Cut out and colour or use coloured paper, card, tissue paper and decorate the plate glass and loafs. Stick to a piece of paper or card and use as a placemat whenever you share bread and squash/wine.
- Colour in the pictures, do dot to dots. word search, crosswords.



BASIC PLAYDOUGH

Playing with dough is a wonderful sensory activity and as with all exploratory experiences it provides a good balance of learning opportunities.

INGREDIENTS

2 cups of plain flour
1 cup of salt
2 tsp. cream of tartar
2 tbsp. cooking oil
2 cups of water
A few drops of food colouring

METHOD

Mix the ingredients together in a pan

Heat the mixture gently over a medium heat, stirring constantly until the dough is stiff and comes away from the sides of the pan.

Tip the dough out on to a board, leave to cool down and then knead well.

The playdough will keep approximately one month (depending on how much use it gets) if kept in an airtight box in the fridge.

MICROWAVE PLAYDOUGH

INDGREDIENTS

1 cup flour
% cup salt
1 cup of water with a few drops of food colouring
2 tbsp. cream of tartar
1 tbsp. oil

METHOD

Stir all ingredients together in bowl Place in microwave on high for 2-3 minutes until makes a dough





AIR DRY CLAY RECIPE


- 1 1/2 cups cornstarch

- 1 Tablespoon baby oil

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



