## Tie Dye Cross Craft

### You will Needed:

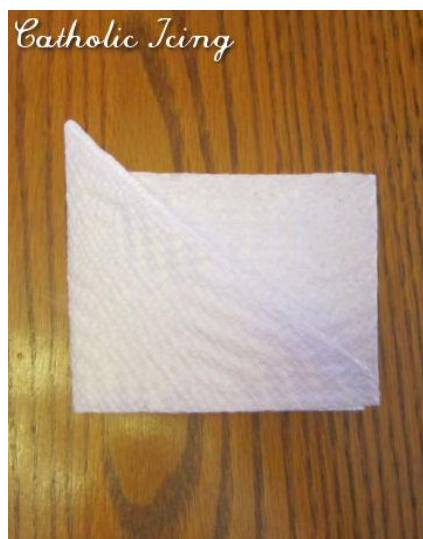
- Plain White Paper Towels- *no patterns!*
- Food colouring mixed with vinegar
- Scissors

First, you need to learn how to make easy fold-and-snip-crosses out of paper towels.

Cut the square kitchen roll into a rectangle. First, bring the bottom right corner up, line up the left edges, and fold. Next, bring up the bottom left corner up, line up the diagonal line, and fold.

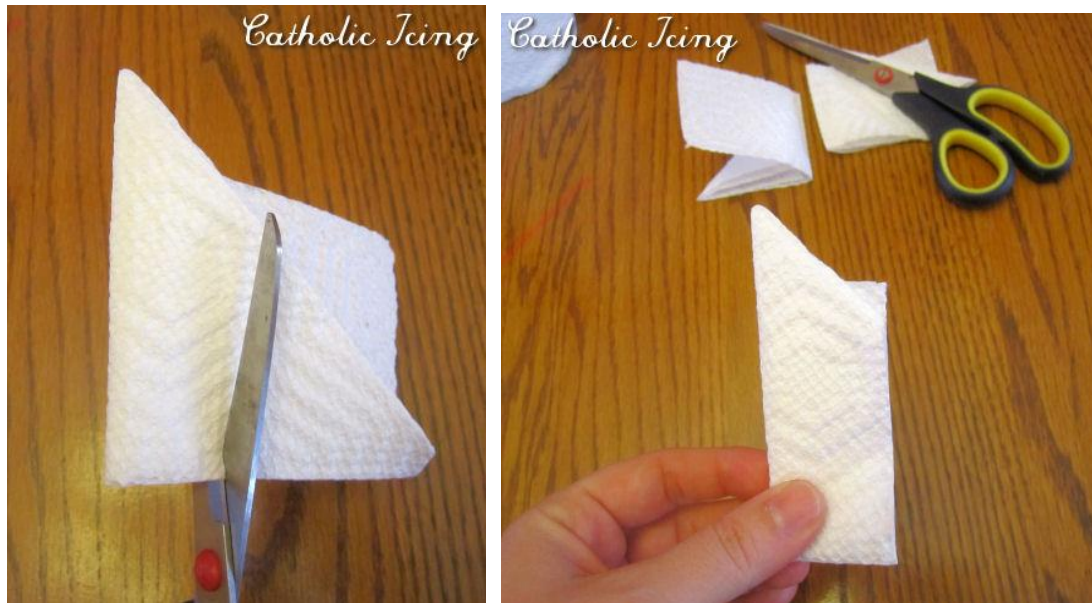


Then, bring the whole bottom triangle up, and fold. Now take your entire paper towel and fold it in half vertically.





All you have left to do is make one snip on the right edge.



Now, here's the fun part! **Before you unfold your cross**, dip the different corners into your food dye to "tie dye" your crosses.



Once it's been dipped, unfold to reveal a beautiful "tie dyed" cross! Leave them to dry flat. When they are dry you could display them in your window.



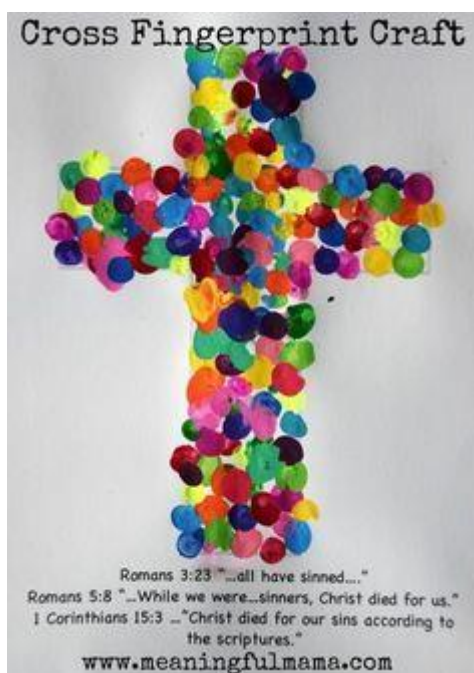
## Lollipop Stick Crosses

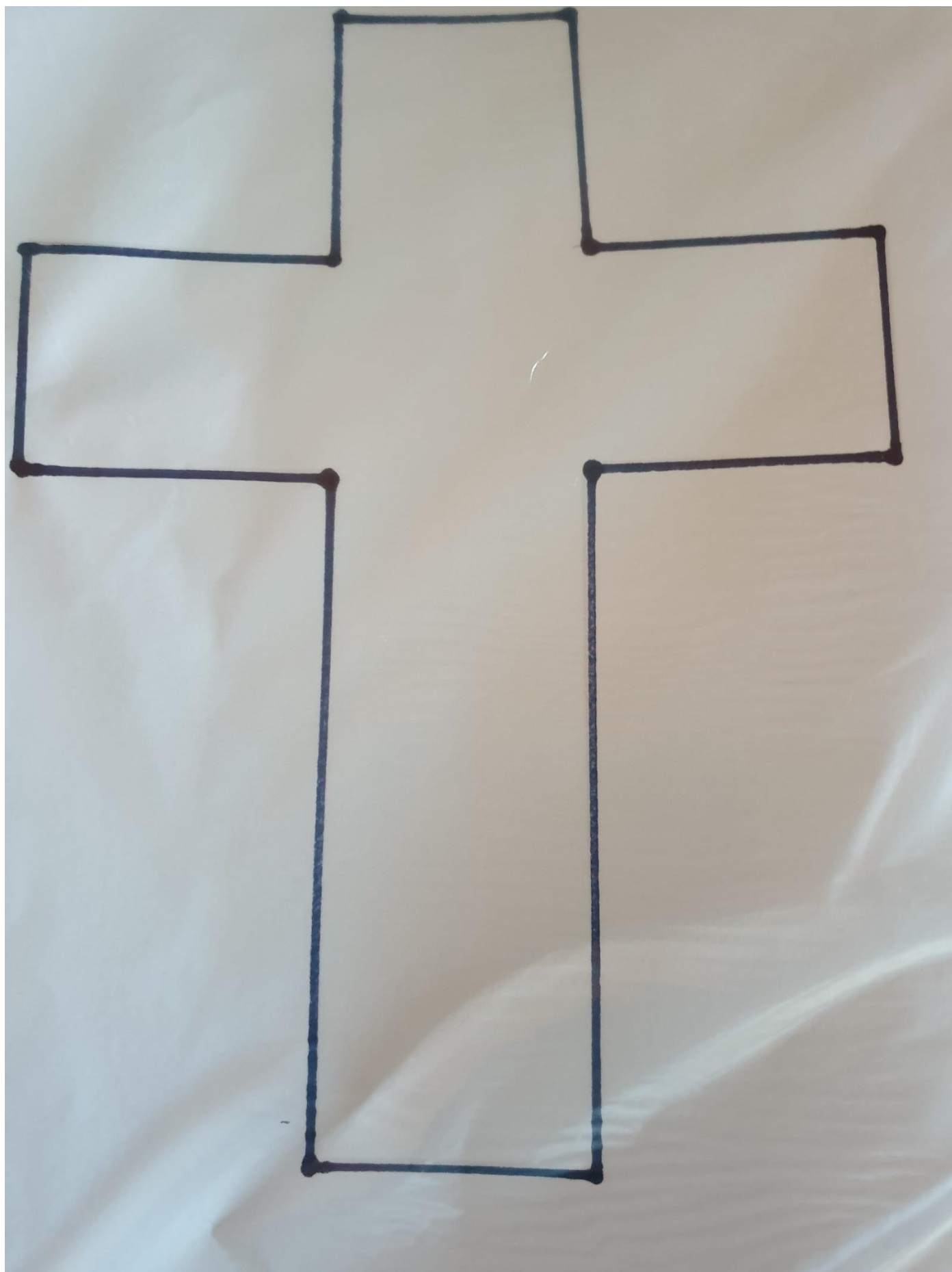

Using the cross template below and brightly coloured paints. Dip your fingers in the paint and decorate the cross with your brightly coloured fingerprints.



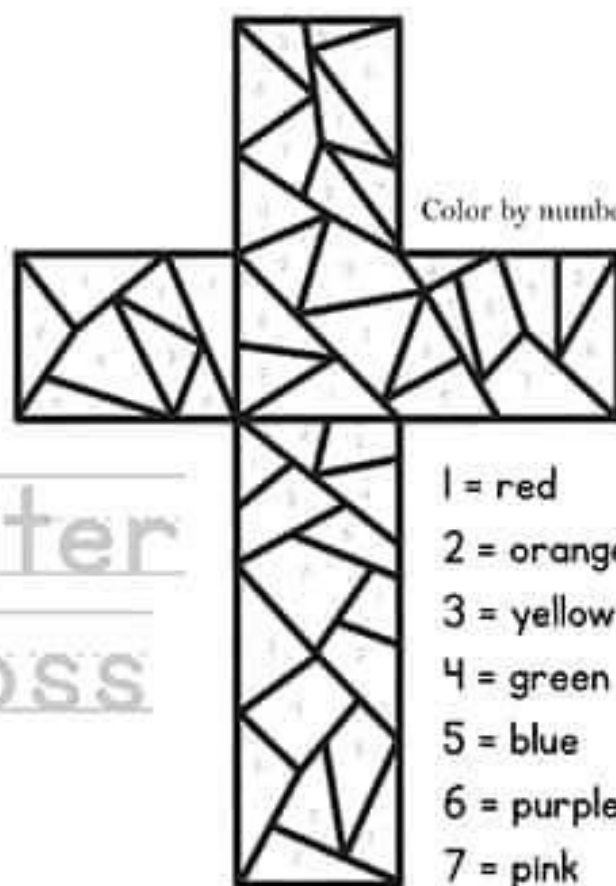
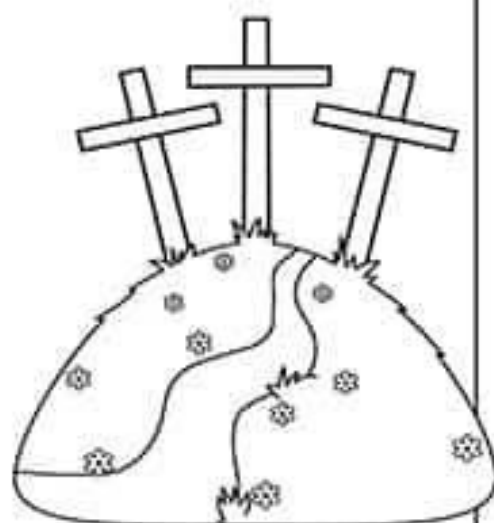
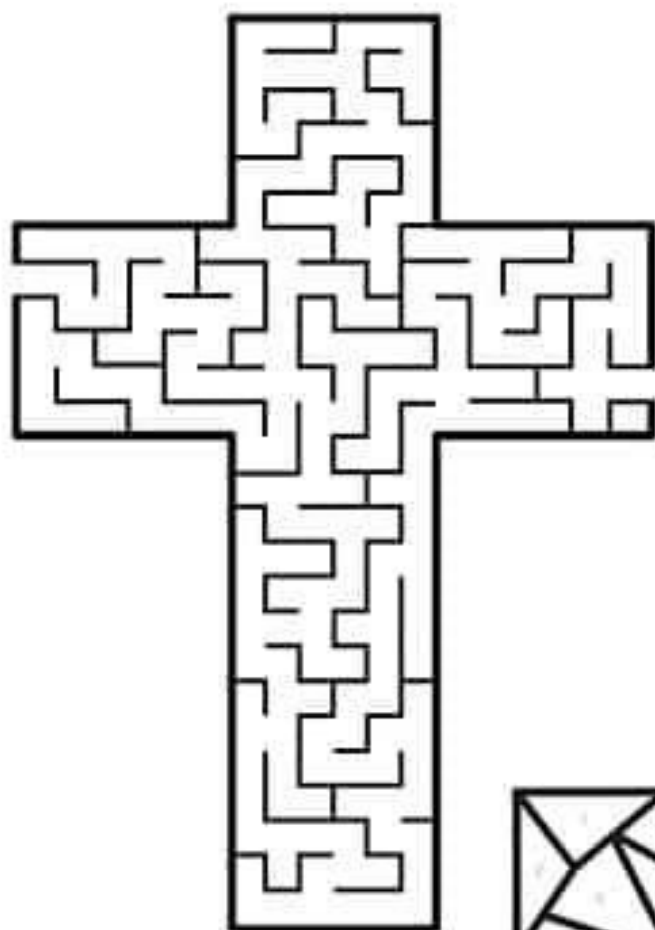




## Decorating Eggs/Stones
