

Celebrate!!

- **Introduction:** Ask the children what was the last celebration/party they had or went to?
- **Activity:** Let the children dress up for a party using some fancy-dress outfits. You could turn this into a relay race and get the children to run put an outfit on, then run back and high five the next person who runs and puts an outfit on. Keep going until everyone has an outfit on.
- **Sing:** Great Big God, Superhero, My Lighthouse, Wiggle Freeze, Wiggle like a Worm.
- **Talk:** What sorts of celebrations do we have? **Birthdays, Weddings, Anniversaries, Baby Showers, Baptisms, Christmas, Easter, Life celebrations/wakes, Graduations/passed exams/driving test.**
Today we are going to look at the feasts/celebrations/festivals that God gave the Israelites after he rescued them from slavery in Egypt. There are 7 annual feasts/festivals which are periods of special worship during the harvest seasons of the year.

- **Discussion:** What is the Sabbath? **It's a day of rest from work on the seventh day of the week that God gave us so we can rest and come together to worship God.** Do we all celebrate the same Sabbath day? **No - Jewish people celebrate the Sabbath on a Saturday and Christians tend to have Sunday as their Sabbath.** God told the Israelites to celebrate the feasts/festivals by resting from work and coming together to worship and offer food and drink to the Lord. What things do we do to celebrate? **Parties, meals out/meals together, BBQ's, receptions, discos, trips out, beach parties.** What do we do at parties/celebrations? **Eat, drink, sing, dance, talk, play games, relax.** What do we eat at parties? **Pizza, sausages, cheese, crisps, hotdogs, chicken nuggets, cake, ice cream, sweets.** I wonder if you can plan and have a celebration for finishing home-schooling and have a summer to relax after your hard work...
- **Pray:** Dear Lord Jesus, Thank you for food and drink. Thank you for places in which we can be sheltered and relax in. Thank you for bringing us through home-schooling. Help us to celebrate, enjoy and rest over the summer after all the hard work we've been doing. Amen!
- **Plan:** A celebration for the summer holidays. Where will it be, what day and time? Plan what games you will play, what prizes, what food will you have. Will it be a fancy-dress party, and if so, what fancy dress theme will you have? You could have superheroes, Tv shows, sport, Disney characters, or your favourite film characters.
- **Design:** Some invitations to your celebration/party. Don't forget to invite everyone in the house and tell them what day and time the party is. What is the dress code: smart, casual or fancy-dress theme? Do they need to bring anything? Make sure its all on the invitation!
- **Make:** Piñatas! Begin by poking a small hole in the bottom of each cup/yoghurt pot and threading a ribbon through. Tie a knot in the ribbon to prevent it from slipping out. Fill cups with sweets or small toys and cover with a piece of tissue paper, using a rubber band to hold it in place. Cut the napkin or tissue paper in to small strips and then fold each strip in half. Cut slits along the fold and then wrap strips around the cup, using sticky tape/glue to keep them in place. Attach strips all the way up and around the cup/yoghurt pot. Sticky tape a piece of ribbon to the tissue paper that is holding all the goodies in. When it's time to break open the piñata, allow the recipient to pull the taped ribbon, causing the tissue paper to rip and the goodies to come spilling out!

- **Have:** Your Celebration/Party and celebrate that you made it through home-schooling and into the summer holidays! Woo Hoo!!



How to Make Mini Pinatas!

You will need: -

- Paper Cups/Yoghurt pots
- Colourful Napkins or Tissue Paper or Coloured Card
- Sticky Tape/Glue
- Ribbon
- Sweets and Small Toys to fill the pinatas with
- Rubber band

Method:

1. Begin by poking a small hole in the bottom of each cup/yoghurt pot and threading a ribbon through.
2. Tie a knot in the ribbon to prevent it from slipping out.
3. Fill cups with sweets or small toys and cover with a piece of tissue paper, using a rubber band to hold it in place.
4. Cut the napkin or tissue paper into small strips and then fold each strip in half.
5. Cut slits along the fold and then wrap strips around the cup, using sticky tape/glue to keep them in place.
6. Attach strips all the way up and around the cup.
7. Sticky tape a piece of ribbon to the tissue paper that is holding all the goodies in.
8. When it's time to break open the piñata, allow the recipient to pull the taped ribbon, causing the tissue paper to rip and the goodies to come spilling out!


