OUR CHURCH ACTION PLAN FOR 2020

At the beginning of this year the PCC agreed certain 'Aims & Objectives' to work on during the next 12 months. A sheet listing these objectives is now attached to the notice board at back of the Church. Do take a look and if you have any comments or questions please talk to a PCC member. We would welcome more involvement to achieve these targets so if you are able to help, please let us know.

PEWS FOR SALE

The long awaited redevelopment work will commence on Monday 20th April. During the work all church services will be in the large hall. The small hall will remain available for some activities. We expect to be back in church for Sunday 24th May.

The work includes a new floor so the pews must be removed on the 20th. As the pews are to be replaced with chairs, a commercial buyer will take 35 of the long pews, we will retain 13 various sized pews, leaving 29 short pews. These 29 pews are mostly 1.5m long and we are offering them for sale at £75 each. This is to members of the congregation and their families, on a first come first served basis, names to the Office. We cannot deliver, the buyer must collect, by arrangement and **no later than Monday 20th April**. We can arrange for pews to be trimmed to a particular length, free of charge. If a buyer has good reason to want a particular pew, we will do our best to arrange this but it will not generally be possible.
