The Electoral Roll will open for amendments and additions on Sunday 1st March 2020.

**No further additions or amendments for 2020 will be accepted after
Tuesday 31st March.**

The Electoral Roll is the basic list in every parish of all those entitled to attend, and to vote at, the Annual Parochial Church Meeting. (*Our APCM this year is on Sunday 26th April immediately after the morning service.*) Electoral rolls provide an indication of the real membership and strength of the Church.

Those entitled to have their names on the roll have to be baptised adults (over 16 years) who live in the parish, or who have worshipped regularly (*i.e. a minimum of once a month*) at St. George's for at least six months and are committed to being part of the life of the local Church of England congregation.

Enrolment is a way of saying...."I belong".

For us it is an act of commitment to St. George's Church and the Church as a whole. It opens the way for a greater involvement in the life of the Church at parish, deanery, diocesan and national level.

- **Please check your details on the current Electoral Roll when it is displayed from next Sunday and then complete a form to make any amendments or to join for the first time. These will be available in church or by downloading from our web site.**

- We take your privacy very seriously at St George's. Please read the Electoral Roll Privacy Notice which is on the web site and will be on display with the Electoral Roll; this sets out how we will use the information you supply on your Electoral Roll Application.

PEWS FOR SALE

The long awaited redevelopment work will commence on Monday 20th April. During the work all church services will be in the large hall. The small hall will remain available for some activities. We expect to be back in church for services on Sunday 24th May.

There are 29 pews, are mostly 1.5m long, for sale at £75 each. This is to members of the congregation and their families, on a first come first served basis.
