The Electoral Roll opens for amendments and additions today Sunday 1st March 2020.

No further additions or amendments for 2020 will be accepted after Tuesday 31st March.

The Electoral Roll is the basic list in every parish of all those entitled to attend, and to vote at, the Annual Parochial Church Meeting. (Our APCM this year is on Sunday 26th April immediately after the morning service.) Electoral rolls provide an indication of the real membership and strength of the Church.

Those entitled to have their names on the roll have to be baptised adults (over 16 years) who live in the parish, or who have worshipped regularly (i.e. a minimum of once a month) at St. George's for at least six months and are committed to being part of the life of the local Church of England congregation.

Enrolment is a way of saying...."I belong".

For us it is an act of commitment to St. George's Church and the Church as a whole. It opens the way for a greater involvement in the life of the Church at parish, deanery, diocesan and national level.

- Please check your details on the current Electoral Roll (at the back of the church) and then complete a form to make any amendments or to join for the first time. These are available in church or by downloading from our web site.
- We take your privacy very seriously at St George's. Please read the Electoral Roll Privacy Notice which is on the web site on display with the Electoral Roll; this sets out how we will use the information you supply on your Electoral Roll Application.

We cannot deliver, the buyer MUST collect,


