#### **Plans for Sundays**

A major difference for us in this lockdown is that churches are not being shut, and we may hold socially distanced services as we have been doing. However, the new strains of the virus present significantly increased risk, as evidence by the introduction of a new lockdown, and the news reports on numbers in hospitals. In recognition of this we are not continuing as usual.

#### **Option 1: Service Video on YouTube at Home**

As has happened previously in lockdowns we will be producing a service video which will be available to view on our YouTube channel. This can be watched from home. We strongly encourage all those who are "highly vulnerable" to stay at home and watch the video rather than coming to church. We love you and want you to stay safe and well. We recognise, though, that meeting together is a spiritually valuable activity for Christians.
