A message from John

Thank you to everyone who has been in touch about the arrangements for church during this current lockdown. It has been good to hear from a number of you about your support and understanding in these difficult circumstances.

Last week's hybrid approach to Sunday services with the production of a pre-recorded video, and the showing of that video in church on Sunday morning seemed to go well, although we only had around 20 attendees. Comments from those who were present were positive, again thank you, and do keep in touch with all your feedback.

Following last week's experience, and in the light of developments in the last seven days the PCC standing committee has decided to close the church building for services for the time being. This is because of the risks of infection, many of which are heightened or still unquantified at this time, a desire to be seen to be taking the danger seriously, and financially it is difficult to justify heating the building on a freezing winter morning for less than 20 people.

I appreciate that responses to this decision will vary. Please be assured that we are not wanting to give up the habit of meeting together (Heb 10:25), but that our overriding desire to be identified as belonging to Jesus because of our love for one another (John 13:35) and for our neighbours (Matt 22:39) is guiding our decisions.

We will keep this decision under prayerful review, and look to reopen safely at the earliest opportunity. When we do, the hybrid model we developed for last week may well be the path we follow for a period as people manage their own risks.

In the meantime, do look out for our weekly Sunday service videos on YouTube – if you subscribe to our channel you will get updates when they become available. **Families,** we are making a special effort to provide a kids slot in the video so you can watch together on a Sunday, with activity sheets available too for you to do with your children, and some colouring to keep them occupied during the service too. Let us know how you get on! Kathryn is doing a great job producing videos for
