GDPR

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into effect in May 2018. It is a legal framework that sets guidelines for the collection and processing of personal information from individuals and all organisations, even St George's, have to adhere to it. By filling in a GDPR consent form you tell us what of your contact information you are happy for us to have and how you are happy for us to use it. In return we agree to keep your information safe and secure.
