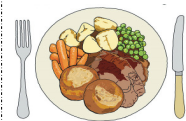

## Modern Slavery Ambassador Commissioning

In partnership with the Roman Catholic Diocese of Arundel and Brighton, Together in Sussex is setting up a network of Modern Slavery Ambassadors across the Diocese of Chichester to promote and inform this work.

The Bishop of Lewes, Rt Revd Will Hazelwood, and the Bishop of Arundel and Brighton, Rt Revd Richard Moth, will commission four ambassadors from the Diocese of Chichester and ten from the Roman Catholic Diocese on Anti-Slavery Day, Monday 18th October at a special service at St John the Evangelist Catholic Church, Horsham at 6pm.

The event will mark the launch of the initiative where Bishop Alastair Redfern, the national lead for the Clewer Initiative, will be the keynote speaker.

The four ambassadors from the Chichester Diocese include our own **Sue Foster**.

Please keep all the ambassadors and the work of anti-slavery in your prayers.
