### Acorn Pregnancy Counselling Centre Informal AGM

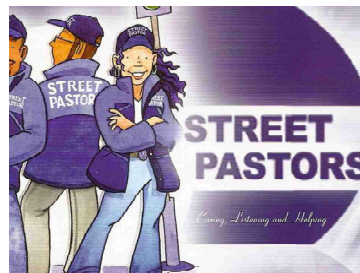
**Monday 21st June 7pm via Zoom**
