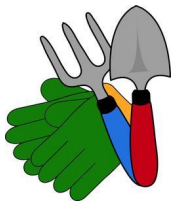

Refreshments After the Service

We have had a lot of very positive feed-back about the way that refreshments are served after the service. Sitting at tables has led to some lovely conversations and chances to get to know people a lot better. Old friendships interrupted by Covid restrictions have been rekindled and new friendships have been made. However, in order to continue serving refreshments in this way, once all Covid restrictions have been lifted, we need more volunteers to come forward to be stewards or servers - to collect orders from those sitting at the tables, get them made up by the coffee team at the servery, then serve them to the table. Ideally we would like 2 stewards every week to work alongside those on the Coffee Rota. If this is something you would like to do please get in touch with Helen in the Church Office.
