Christmas then Easter...

At Christmas we enjoyed a real tree in the church garden that was decorated with baubles by the church family.

But what has happened to the tree? Well you can't have Christmas without Easter, the two go together. Christmas as we celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ and Easter when we remember His Death and celebrate His resurrection and hope and love in new life.

The tree has been stripped back of its foliage and now stands as a bare cross in the church garden where the Christmas tree once stood reminding us of the sacrifice that Jesus made for each one of us. As we enter Holy week you are invited to add new life, hope, and love to the base of the tree in the form of flowers.
