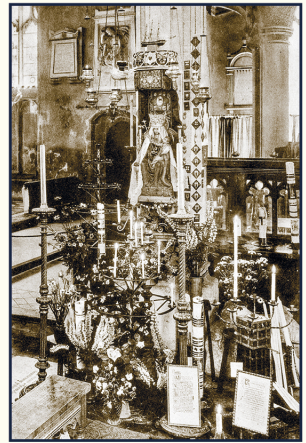




The Friends of Saint Mary Walsingham

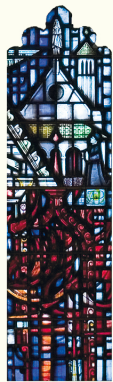
