

Tremorran Quiet Garden Visit

“Tremorran is part of the [Quiet Garden Movement](#). Quiet Gardens provide hospitality and a safe, quiet space for coming home to oneself, for spiritual contemplation and reflection. People can come 'Back to the Garden' anytime.

The garden is set in the grounds of Tremorran which was built as a mine captain's house at the turn of the 1900's. There is a maze of paths perfect for prayer walks, separate gardens to discover on the walks... the studio garden with lily pond, kitchen garden, orchard, the west lawn with a fish pond, fuchsia alley and secret garden. The gardens are furnished with seating, sculptures and standing slates to aid meditation and prayer. A granite labyrinth in the paddock provides further time for thought and prayer.”
