SERVICES IN CHURCH

The Government announcement concerning the end of most Covid regulations leaves organisations and individuals to decide how to act safely and to prevent the spread of Coronavirus. After receiving guidance from the Church of England and our diocese, we are <u>recommending</u> that anyone coming to church continues to wear a face covering. We are assessing the best way to seat people safely to avoid unnecessary anxiety, but there will be no need to register for services. If you wish to sing you will have to wear a face covering. We will review the situation at the end of August. Our 10am Sunday service will remain livestreamed as well as being in person.

The church office is open on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays 9am–noon. You will have to press the intercom button in the foyer if you need to see someone in the office. We encourage you to continue to wear a face covering and use hand sanitiser when you visit the church.
