NOTICEBOARD

SERVICES IN CHURCH

We are <u>recommending</u> that anyone coming to church continues to wear a face covering. If you wish to sing you will have to wear a face covering. Our 10am Sunday service will remain livestreamed as well as being in person.

HOLY COMMUNION

We are testing a partial return to "normal" at all our Communion services. <u>Today</u>, we will continue to offer the bread only, but ask you to receive at the nave altar step. Wherever you are sitting you will need to walk up the south aisle (this will mean walking to the back of church first if you are in the north aisle), sanitise your hands just in front of the Lady Chapel, then walk across to the nave altar step where a wafer will be dropped into your hand. <u>From Wednesday</u> we will add the opportunity for those who wish to to receive wine by intinction. This will require you to do the same process, but if you do NOT wish to receive a wafer dipped in the wine (this will be done safely and according to health guidelines) please say, "wafer only." If you have mobility problems Communion will be brought to you in your seat.

OFFICE OPENING

The church office is open from 9.00am – noon, Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The church is generally open during the day Monday-Friday for private prayer.
