

NOTICEBOARD

SERVICES IN CHURCH

Anyone coming to church must wear a face covering. Except for the choir, you must keep your mask on when singing. Our 10.00am Sunday service will remain livestreamed as well as being in person. **Refreshments** are available in the Church Centre after our 10am service for those who wish to stay.

HOLY COMMUNION

At all our **Communion services** we offer bread and wine but ask you to receive at the nave altar step. You need to walk up the south aisle, sanitise your hands just in front of the Lady Chapel, then walk across to the nave altar step where a wafer will be dropped into your hand. Those who wish to can receive wine by intinction. If you do NOT wish to receive a wafer dipped in the wine please say, "wafer only." You should then return to your seat, remove your mask and consume the wafer. If you have mobility problems Communion will be brought to you in your seat.

OFFICE OPENING

The **church office is currently not open to callers.** However, someone will be able to take calls and answer emails from 9.00am – noon, Monday, Wednesday and Friday. The church is usually open Monday-Friday mornings for private prayer.
