SERVICES IN CHURCH

With the easing of Covid restrictions in common with many other venues we leave the decision to wear a face covering up to you, though ask that you remain aware of and respectful to others around you. Our 10.00am Sunday service will remain livestreamed as well as being in person.

HOLY COMMUNION

At our **Communion services** we offer bread and wine. At Sunday 10am services, walk up the south aisle, sanitising your hands, then walk across to the nave altar step. The priest will either drop a wafer into your hand and you can move on to an assistant who will offer the chalice OR if you wish to receive a wafer dipped in the wine the priest will intinct using a different chalice. Please make it clear which you would prefer by saying "dip" if you wish to receive an intincted wafer – otherwise please move on to the assistant who will administer the wine to you from the chalice. If you do NOT wish to receive a wafer dipped in the wine please say, "wafer only."

The **church office is open to callers** from 9.00am – noon on Monday, Wednesday and Friday this week. The church is usually open Monday-Friday mornings for private prayer.
