Growth Enabler posts, one for each archdeaconry. They will come alongside parishes to help them further establish a vision for numerical and spiritual growth, using the excellent toolkit created by our own clergy and lay leaders.

"What they won't do is tell people how to do things, like the worst kind of management consultant. They won't have pre-programmed answers from a one size fits all checklist. They won't audit the church they visit."

#### **Presidential Address**

Bishop James spoke to Synod about the common theme of stewardship that ran through all the items on the agenda.

"Stewardship in the broad sense of how we guard, grow, and pass on that which is entrusted to us."

Referencing the first letter of Peter, Bishop James said that we are encouraged there in, "our stewardship of God's grace in its various forms."

This included being stewards of creation, of our resources and of the Gospel:

"Without that faithfulness of discipleship and the life of prayer - the other things become mere good activity rather than faithful and fruitful following of Christ."
