Can you find a way to remember the memory verse together?


Memory Verse

Hebrews 11 v 1

Faith means being sure of the things we hope for and knowing that something is real even if we do not see it.

Family Fun Together

Wind football: Set up a wind football table, scrunch up paper to make a ball and set up two goals one at each end of the table. Work individually or in family teams, using paper straws to blow the ball and trying to score goals.



Faith is believing in something even though we can't see it. We cannot see the wind but we can see the way it impacts objects around it.

Connect with God Together

In this passage from Hebrews we think about the many amazing things God's people have done through the years because of their Faith. We can believe in God for amazing things too and believe that God will use us to do amazing things.

Spend some time chatting with God together, sharing some of your big hopes and dreams for the future. Pray and ask God to help them become a reality.

You might also like to take time to listen to God and catch what He might be sharing about the amazing plans He has for your future too. Remember that God can speak to us in many ways: through pictures in our imaginations, words, verses, song lyrics or our feelings and emotions.

Faith Challenge

When we have faith in God it changes the way we live our lives, we want to share our faith with others so that they can know God too. Could you share your faith with another family this week?

Offer to pray for a family you know who aren't yet full of faith. Pray that they would come to know God and develop their own faith.
