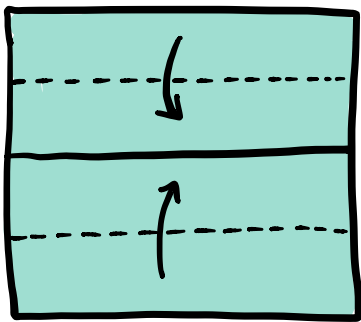


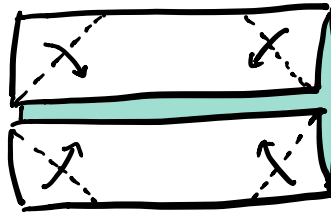


How to Fold an Origami Boat

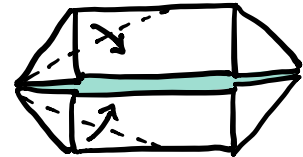
Note: This works with either a square or rectangular piece of paper.



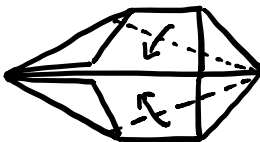
1. Fold the paper into half.
2. Fold the top and bottom sides to the centre line.



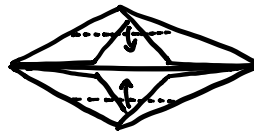
3. Fold the four corners towards the centre line.



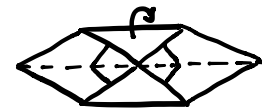
4. Fold the two left corners towards the centre line.



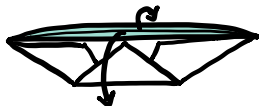
5. Fold the two right corners towards the centre line.



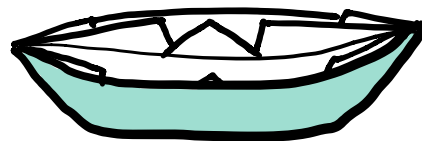
6. Fold the top and bottom corners towards the centre line.



7. Fold behind.

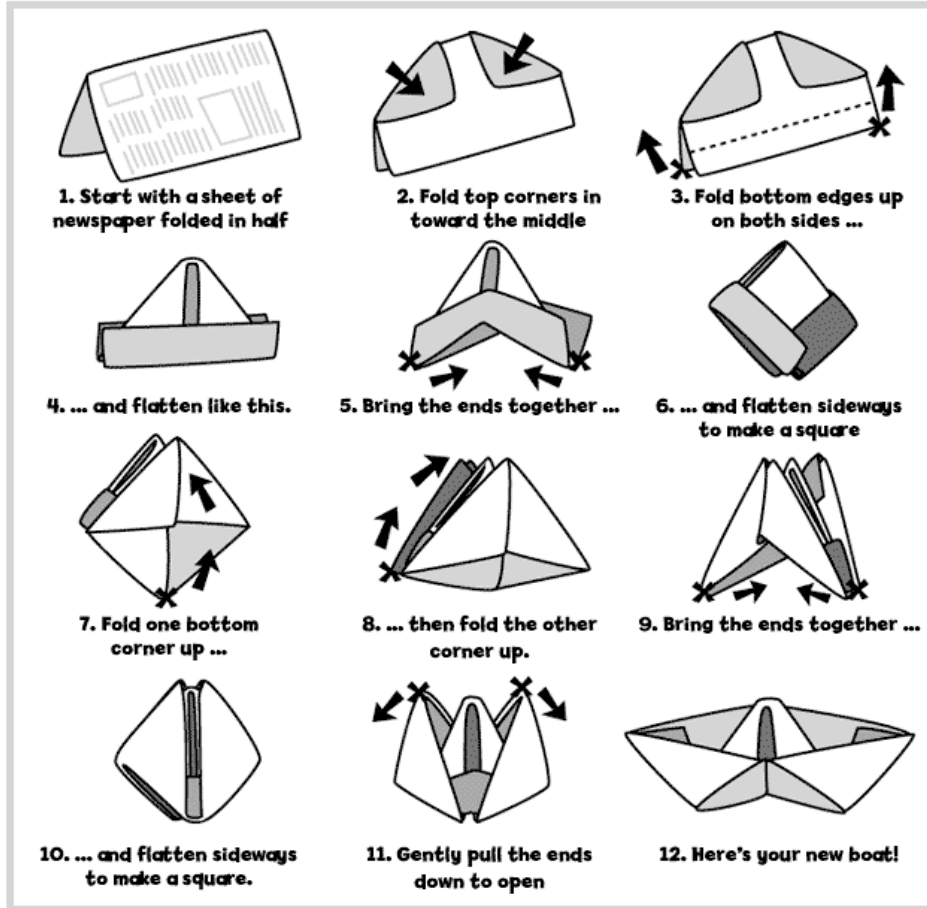


8. Flip inside out.



9. Completed boat.
