Appointment of Professional Advisor.

St Guthlac's Church, Stathern, Leicestershire LE14 4HB is a Grade II* listed building. The services of a Professional Advisor with conservation accreditation and ideally with knowledge of the National Lottery Heritage Fund (NHLF) is required to plan and direct repair works at this church. The works required are: a) repairs to the chancel and vestry walls of the church which may involve wall ties or anchors, together with associated plaster repairs, and b) repairs to the tower which may require renewal of some ironstone walling. Both of these projects have been advised in the 2021 Quinquennial Report and the PCC is likely to apply for grants for one or both of them.

The process of appointment will follow the Leicester Diocesan Note "The appointment of a Professional Advisor and/or Lead Consultant".
