The bore hole well at Agata was dug in 2006.

During the *Walk for Water* in September last year we were joined by Archdeacon Abiodun Ogunyemi . He was able to tell us about his home Diocese of Kaduna in Northern Nigeria (with which we are linked).

He told us about the plight of villagers who do not have an adequate water supply and we were able to raise enough money for a borehole for the village of Agata.



Abiodun took me to Agata. It is a very isolated community and they are excited about the prospect of having a borehole. It will transform their lives. CHAKWAMA WELL

The well at Chakwama village was dug in April 2005.

The money for the well was raised by the children of Finham Primary School was achieved by holding various fund raising events.



During the mission by Ann and Jim Saxton in early 2005 they visited Chakwama village met with the elders and chief, and accompanied by Rev Peter Awaka viewed the place where the well was to be dug. Whilst there they saw the children on their way back from a 2 mile round trip to collect water from the nearest water supply.



It appeared that the whole village came to mark the spot where the well was to be dug.



Before leaving Kaduna state Ann and Jim called in to Chakwama on their way the the Airport and saw the well being dug by hand.
