

# Intercultural Worship and Events Enabler

## Job Description

**Salary:** £35,000 pro rata (£18,000 pa)

**Hours:** 18 hours a week.

**Location:** Activity at St Chad & St Mark's Church, with some home working.

**Employed by:** Parish of Central Wolverhampton

**Responsible to:** Incumbent, St Chad & St Mark

### **Main Purpose:**

To work alongside the vicar and other clergy to develop the musical and liturgical life of this unique and diverse congregation and to facilitate the development of a programme of events that celebrate the cultural diversity of the congregation, so that after three years the congregation is confident with a range of songs and musical worship that makes the best use of its talents and there is a pattern of events that celebrate the cultural and ethnic diversity of the congregation.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Researching and proposing suitable music, hymns and songs for this community that are drawn from the cultural backgrounds of community members with a focus on worship and songs that represent traditions from those communities.
2. Identifying and encouraging musical talents within the congregation for instance helping to develop and expand our existing musical styles presently organ and drumming groups and developing intercultural choir/singing/music groups.
3. A willingness to engage and resource the multilingual nature of our congregation and help to resource the representation of that in liturgy and worship
4. Leading rehearsals and worship and identifying and resourcing potential worship leaders from amongst the congregation.
5. Recording 'the journey' and noting what has worked, what hasn't worked, and why.
6. Facilitating the development of a programme of events that celebrate the cultural diversity of the congregation and the wider community enabling congregational members to take a lead in the planning and development of this programme .
7. Working with the Ministry Team and other staff members to develop the community life of the Church
8. Ensuring that as a community we are capacity building for the future, enabling talents and developing leadership from within the congregation who can work with clergy in deepening the intercultural nature of our liturgy, worship and community life.
9. Undertaking regular supervision with the Incumbent and to participate in the Ministry Team of St Chad's and St Mark's
10. Undertaking other duties which are consistent with the purpose and nature of the post
