WELCOME TO SHORESH STUDY TOURS

A ministry of CMJ (Church's Ministry among Jewish People)

SHORESH programmes are tours with a difference. *Shoresh* is the Hebrew word for root. The tours are particularly designed to help those seeking to appreciate the significance of the Jewish roots of Christianity in a context that encourages spiritual understanding and growth. Romans 11:18 states: "Consider this: You do not support the root, but the root supports you."

Since 1986, Shoresh, with Alexander College, has welcomed thousands of people who want to explore a deeper awareness of the roots of their faith in the lands of the Bible. Whether this will be your first trip or you have travelled before on a Shoresh Study Tour, you will receive fresh insights into the Scriptures as you journey through the lands of the prophets, priests and kings. In your journey of discovery the Land is our classroom and the Bible our textbook.

The Shoresh guides are all committed Christians who will open up the world of the Scriptures through their extensive knowledge of the biblical background and Hebrew language. Shoresh Study Tours will at times take you 'off the beaten track' to enable you to experience more fully the land and the people of the Bible.

In addition to the scheduled site visits, teaching sessions and discussion, we will meet believers from both Jewish and Arab communities in Israel. Opportunity is also given for personal quiet reflection and prayer to listen to the voice of God. Above all it is our desire that during your journey you may meet the Master, and that your experience will be that of the two who walked the Road to Emmaus whose hearts burned within them as He spoke to them on the way.

James writes:

I'm Rev James Hollingsworth, I'm a CofE vicar in Seaford in East Sussex in the Diocese of Chichester. This will be the 2nd tour I've led and the sixth time I've been here. I hope that, with me, you'll find your faith deepened and revived as we visit key places in Scripture and you'll understand why The Holy Land is rightly called the fifth gospel.

There's so much to learn and experience; so many insights to absorb: spiritual, cultural, and biblical. The itinerary covers some of the regular tourist stops (Bethlehem, Nazareth), but we also call at places that bring different perspectives, with opportunities for reflection, inspiration. At some of them, we will pause to worship and celebrate Holy Communion.

We will be exploring the life and world of Jesus: so that means standing on spots where we can know with good certainty that Jesus stood here, and we will stand in other places that are of such significance that they must have happened close by.

We will pray on Mount Carmel and remember Elijah, and float in the Dead Sea and walk through the old city of Jerusalem.

My prayer for us is that we will return with a renewed vision of Jesus and be drawn closer to Him. We look forward to your company as we make this pilgrimage together.
