CHURCHWARDENS AND PCC MEMBERS Our wardens for 2021-22 are Chris Lowe (in his second year) and Lesley Maile. FACULTY FOR PROJECTOR AND SCREEN Do have a look at the formal notice on the Church door and the website. The proposed works are to replace the current portable table-top screen and projector with a fixed projector to be mounted on the Nave side of an aisle, and a wide format screen behind the Chancel Arch. The latter will drop down electronically when needed. Do have a chat with Graham Appleby or Chris Lowe if you want to talk through the plans or have any concerns.

STAGE 3 CORONAVIRUS RESTRICTIONS The change in regulations state that six people or two households can meet indoors. Individuals may therefore attend services in groups of six, or larger groups where everyone present is from the same two households. Face coverings must continue to be worn.
