

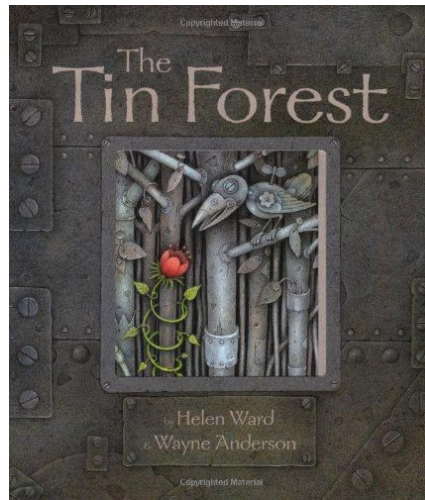
Literacy
