

**Outdoor Learning**— how to look after the planet. We will make bird feeders and will take part in scientific investigations in the outdoors. Children will also collect data from the outdoors to use in maths.

**Music** - To compose a piece of music based upon a picture. Working with class 2 we will each create a piece of contrasting music based upon pictures and perform them to each other to see if we can guess where the music might be portraying. We will also be investigating music from differing cultures.

**P.S.H.C.E.** - The children will be learning about how we can show respect. We will learn some sign language and how we need to respect others who are different to us.

**R.E.** - **Creation/Fall**

**What do Christians learn from the creation story?**

By the end the children will be able to: place the concepts of God and Creation on a timeline, make clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation, describe what Christians do because they believe God the Creator and can ask questions about suggest answers about what might be important in the creation story for Christians living today and for people who are not Christians.

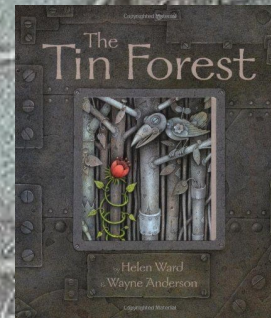
**Maths** – The children will learn how to interpret and present data linked to topic. They will then move onto fractions, decimals and percentages. Towards the end of the Spring term, the children will then move onto geometry (including shape and position and direction work).

**P.E.** - On a Tuesday, years 3 and 4 will be swimming at GL1 and years 5 and 6 will be taking part in a cross country session. On a Friday the whole of KS2 will be learning gymnastics with Mr Harbour.

**Geography** - children will learn about the planet and will learn about sustainability.

# Respect

Spring 2017



**Science**— Children will learn all about animals this term and how we should respect them. They will also touch on scientists and inventors. In the second term the children will learn about relationship and sex education.

**History** - the children will be looking at royalty from the past. We will link this to respect by thinking about how we need to respect our countries history.

**Art** - With Mrs Hodges, the children will begin by completing their current pieces of work. They will then investigate the work of designers and craft workers. They will follow this by making pieces of art out of junk or other materials.

**Languages**— the children will continue to learn basic German. This term they will recap phrases learnt last term as well as learning how to name animals in German and different colours.

**D&T** - In the first half of this term, the children will create their own bird feeders/houses. In the second half of the term, the children will then create packaging for their designs.

**Computing** - The children will become opinion pollsters during this term. They will create their own opinion poll, seek responses, and then analyse the results.

**English**— Children will look at writing to persuade which could include letter writing, speeches and campaigns. The children will also complete non-chronological reports alongside writing to entertain.
