



Science:

This term we will learn about the different types of Rock, both natural and manmade. They will compare and group together different types of rock on the basis of their appearance and simple physical features.

They will learn how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. They will recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

Art :This term we will be looking at the work of architects. We will learn about the work of Frank Lloyd Wright before designing our own buildings to serve the public. We will learn where architects get their inspiration from and use this to guide our own work. We will evaluate work of others as well as our own and will make comments to suggest improvements where necessary.

English:

This term the children will briefly revisit recount and letter writing to consolidate skills taught in the Autumn. We will look at stories with a similar theme and have carefully chosen texts to illustrate this term's value of 'Service'. We will continue to embed new grammatical terms and develop their range of sentence structures and punctuation. We will complete a unit of work on instruction writing and posters as well as reading and creating poetry linked to ideas in our texts.

Maths:

The children will continue to develop their understanding of multiplication and division. This will be enhanced by our regular use of tackling tables and work to secure their rapid recall of multiplication facts. We will then complete a unit of work using money and apply workings using real life situations. We will look at statistics and create tables to represent data. We will explore measuring of length, height and perimeter before concluding the term with a unit of work on fractions. We would appreciate time spent at home in practising the skill of telling the time.
