

English – This term we will be beginning with a focus on ‘The Wind in the Willows’ by Kenneth Grahame. We will use this text to inspire us in our writing of: non-chronological reports, persuasive speeches and book reviews.

After that, we will be working on our poetry including: Haiku, Tanka, Kennings, Cinquian and narrative poems.

Maths – Throughout our Mathematics curriculum, we will be developing our fluency, reasoning and problem solving.

For the first week of term, Year 4 and 5 will recap place value whilst Year 6 work on algebra. After this, we will all move onto Geometry (properties of shapes). Finally, before half term we will all cover statistics.

After half term, we will be consolidating all that we have learnt throughout the year through mathematical investigations.

Science – This term we will focus on two areas of science. Firstly, we will be learning about nature, specifically focussing on the classification of plants, animals and micro-organisms. After this, we will be working practically to investigate irreversible changes.

SPAG – Throughout this term we will be using Alan Peat sentences to improve our punctuation and our grammar. Our spellings will follow the ‘No nonsense’ spelling scheme.

P.S.H.C.E – This term we will be relationships and sex education.

Art – This term we will be looking at the work of crafts people and designers. We will explore the use of clay in art and learn some basic pottery skills. We will learn about designers who work with pottery and create designs of our own. We will evaluate our work and that of others, commenting on areas to improve.

Music – Music specialist Mrs Edwards will be leading music, teaching us to read music and play some musical instruments.


