



Science: (Year 2)

This term we will look closely at plants and flowers. We will learn about their parts and what they need to grow and thrive.

Later we will learn about the differences between bulbs and seeds. We will learn how seeds grow from a seed to a plant and plant a variety of bulbs to observe later in the spring. We will complete some investigating tasks.

Art: Years 3—6

This term we will concentrate on our drawing skills, using mark making techniques with a range of art materials before working to develop our observation skills.

We will look at still life drawings & paintings from famous artists before setting up our own compositions and creating our own still life pieces, using art materials of personal choice.

English: (Year 2)

This term we will revisit the 'leader feeder' handwriting style and set clear expectations for our written work. We will work on securing basic sentence punctuation for the four main types of sentence, and learn some new sentence structures. We will start the term with a traditional tale and an innovation before writing our own. Later we will read the story of the Pinocchio and compare and contrast with the film. We will practise the skill of storytelling and create story maps to help us retell tales. We will use the stories to inspire our writing for different purposes, and will use these texts to support our reading comprehension skills.

Maths: (Years 2 & 3)

This term the children will focus on three main themes. We will start by consolidating our understanding of place value. We will use a variety of mathematical manipulatives and drawn visual methods of showing numbers. We will move on to addition and subtraction work where we will learn new methods of calculation. Later on we will cover multiplication and division. Throughout these themes we will work to improve their fluency, problem solving and reasoning skills.
