

English – For our writing this term we will be covering many different text types. These include; recounts, debates, persuasive writing, biographies, play scripts, letters, stories with dilemmas and book reviews.

In our guided reading, we will continue to develop our E.R.I.C skills using a wide variety of texts.

Art – This term we will concentrate on our drawing skills, using mark making techniques with a range of art materials before working to develop our observation skills. We will look at still life drawings & paintings from famous artists before setting up our own compositions and creating our own still life pieces, using art materials of personal choice.

Outdoor learning – We are extremely fortunate to be surrounded by an area rich for outdoor learning, from woodland, to rivers and even the local scout centre. We will be using these areas regularly to develop personal and social skills, communication, problem solving, thinking skills and teamwork.

Computing – This term with Miss Young the children will be learning about stop motion animation. They will be learning about how stop motion animation is created and will end the term by creating their own stop motion film.

Science – We will begin this term with a continuation of irreversible materials before we study light. After this, we will look at air and water resistance before studying micro-organisms.


Music – With Mrs Edwards, we will be concentrating mainly on animals within music and will be composing short pieces of music using different tuned and untuned percussion instruments.
