Art : In Art this term the children will be working with Mrs Hodges once a fortnight on a Monday afternoon.

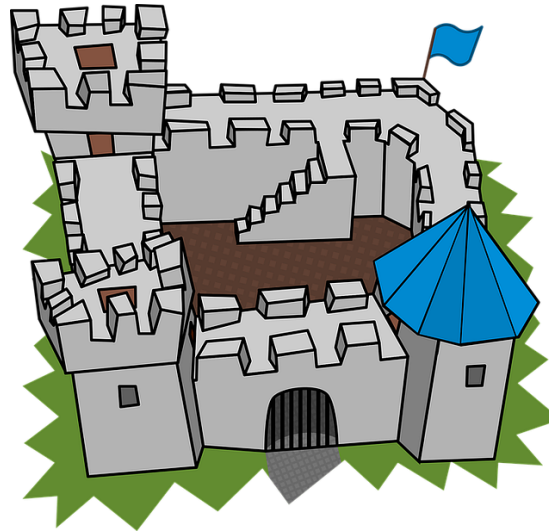
Music: This term the children will be looking at continuing a beat, as well as creating their own beat for others to follow. They will be using a range of percussion instruments and using symbols
