

Maths

In the spring term the children in year 4 will be continuing their work on multiplication and division. We will then be moving onto looking at area. We will then be moving onto spending the second half of the term on decimals and fractions.

Throughout the term the children will also be continuing to practise their timetables along with a regular mental maths slot once a week.

English

Computing
