This sentence creates a clear picture for the reader.</p> </div> <div data-bbox="925 963 1468 1366" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold;">4Ad</p> <p>Examples: a) Mr Twit was a dirty, horrible man with long, soggy spaghetti in his beard. b) It was a sparse, dry desert with a calming, exotic oasis in the distance.</p> <p style="font-size: 0.8em;">Rule: A 4Ad sentence has TWO adjectives before the first noun and TWO adjectives before the second noun. This sentence creates a clear picture for the reader.</p> </div>
