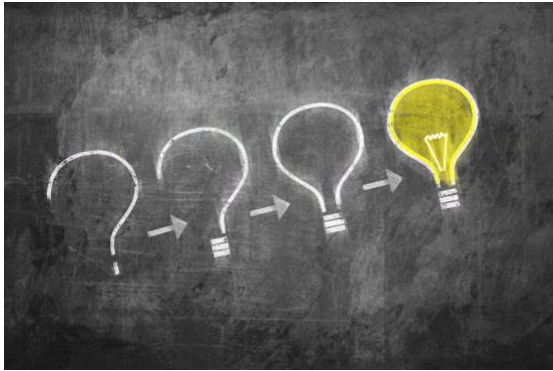
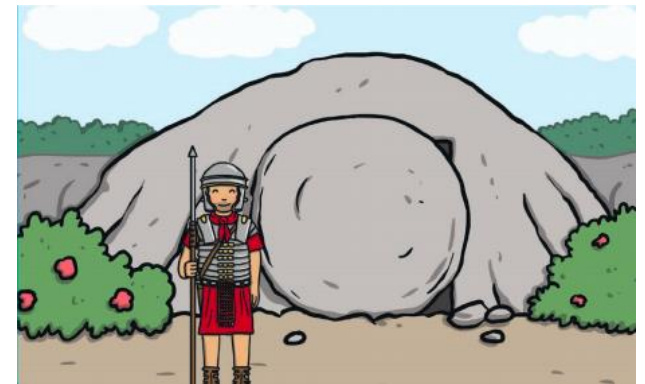


Use the pictures to help retell the story of Easter

Palm Sunday
