


This week, we are looking at adding a suffix to root words . . .

For example:




What happens to the root word when the suffix -ous is added to it in these words?


Nothing! The suffix -ous is added straight onto these root words.


Working with a partner, how many words can you think of that have the suffix **-ous** added with no change to the root word?


How many of this week's spelling words did you and your partner come up with?



















Here are your spelling words for this week.
