Last night of the Proms

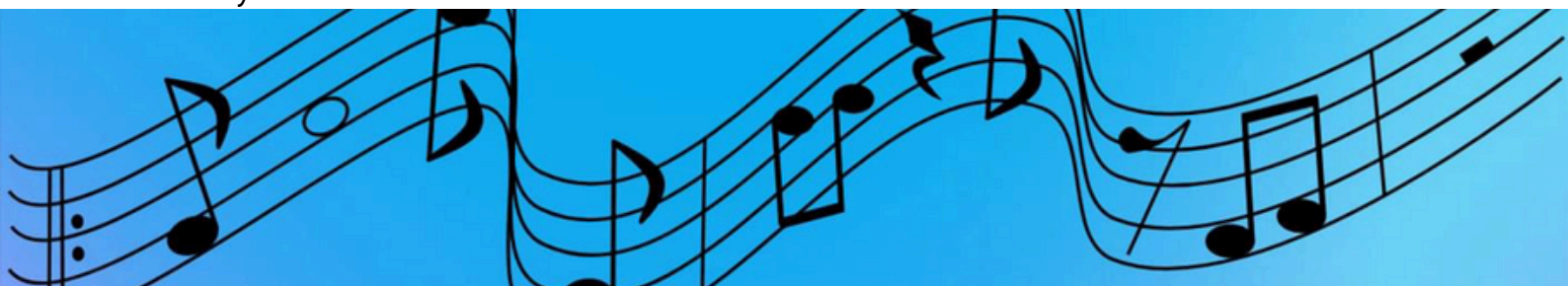
