

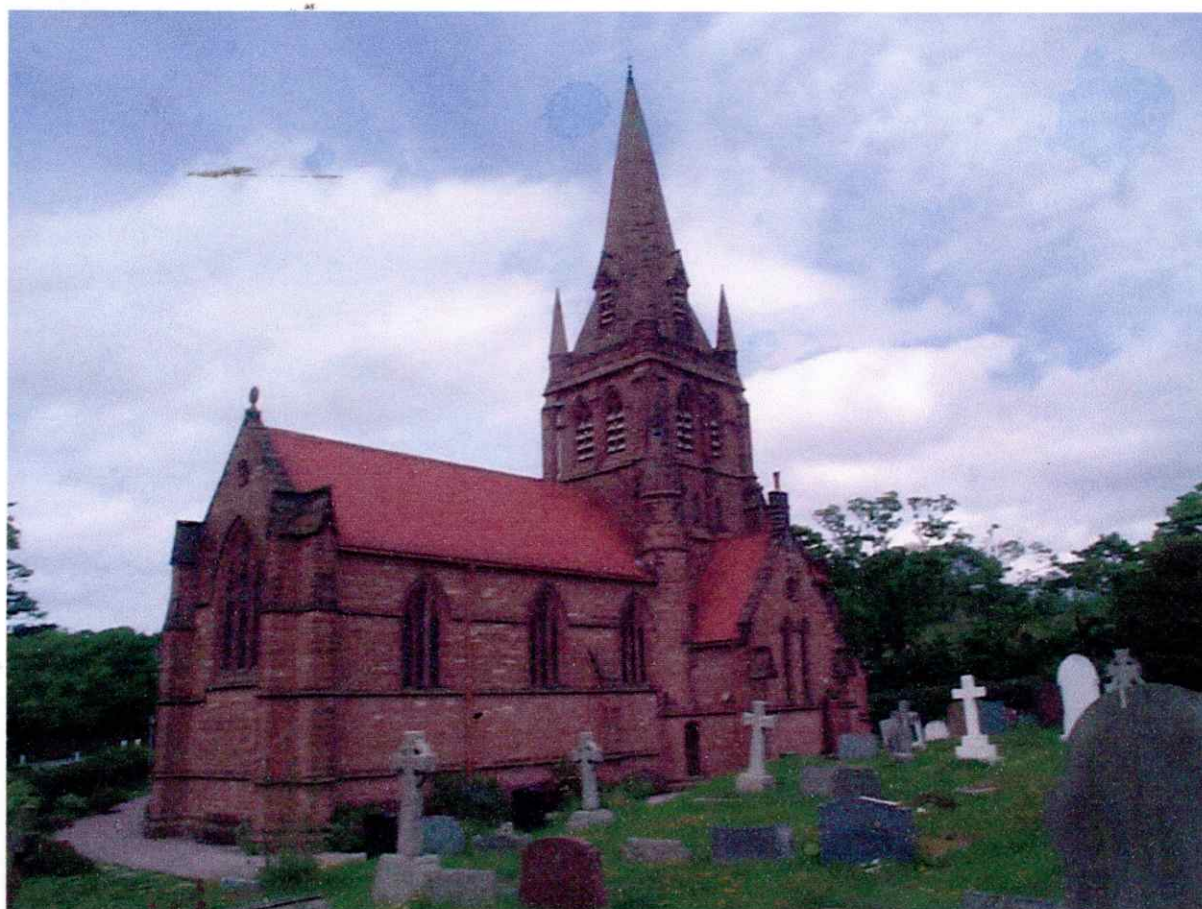

Introduction

The parish of Thurstaston lies high above rolling meadows at the end of the ridge which runs along the Dee from Shotwick. The present church, the third to occupy the site, was dedicated to St. Bartholomew and was built in memory of Joseph Hegan of Dawpool by his two daughters at a cost of £6,000. This church has been described as one of the most perfect of Wirral's modern (19th century) churches and was erected in 1885 followed by consecration the following year on the 7th January 1886. The church interior has been the subject of comprehensive studies by various other societies in the past and the results can be seen at the back of the church.

The tower of the previous church, built in 1824, remains standing in the small ancient churchyard which is enclosed within rough-hewn stone walls. On the whole, the graves are sited in fairly regular rows with the earlier stones lying nearest the old tower. The more recent cremation stones and tablets border the boundary wall in Section A. The small Garden of Remembrance is planted up and incorporates flower vases around the perimeter, however, there are no individual memorial plaques.

There are several 17th century gravestones amongst the time-worn headstones including a flat sandstone memorial to Revd. Robert BRADSHAW who died in 1689. He is one of a number of clergy buried in the churchyard over the centuries.

Although the tender ages on so many memorials in this last resting place of the country-folk of old show testament to a hard life, there were some who lived to a ripe old age. Rich STOLE and his wife Esther were both in their nineties, Esther was almost ninety seven, when they died in 1774 and 1775 respectively. More recently, two centenarians are recorded: Beatrice JONES in 1996 and Emma KENDRICK in 2003.

There are a number of war memorials in the churchyard, one whose name was a test of our skill at accurate transcribing! He was Captain Victor Feodor Lorisovitch ROUGEAULT-CENIAVINE of the Lancashire Fusiliers who was only twenty seven years of age when he was killed in action in the Second World War. There is also a monument to Lieut Colonel John Baskervyle GLEGG of the 49th Regiment in which he served his country 39 years. He died at Thurstaston Hall in 1861 aged 87.

In Section C the name of REALEY appears on ten headstones, all in close proximity. However, by far the most impressive edifice in the churchyard is the ornate sarcophagus to the memory of Thomas Henry ISMAY and his wife Margaret. Thomas who purchased the Dawpool estate was the founder of the White Star Line of Steamers and most of the great oceans of the world would have seen his flag.

We started work in May 2005 and finished all the recording by the end of October. Although it took only five months to transcribe the churchyard the ensuing wet weather, together with other complications, delayed the final checking and consequently the printing for quite some time.

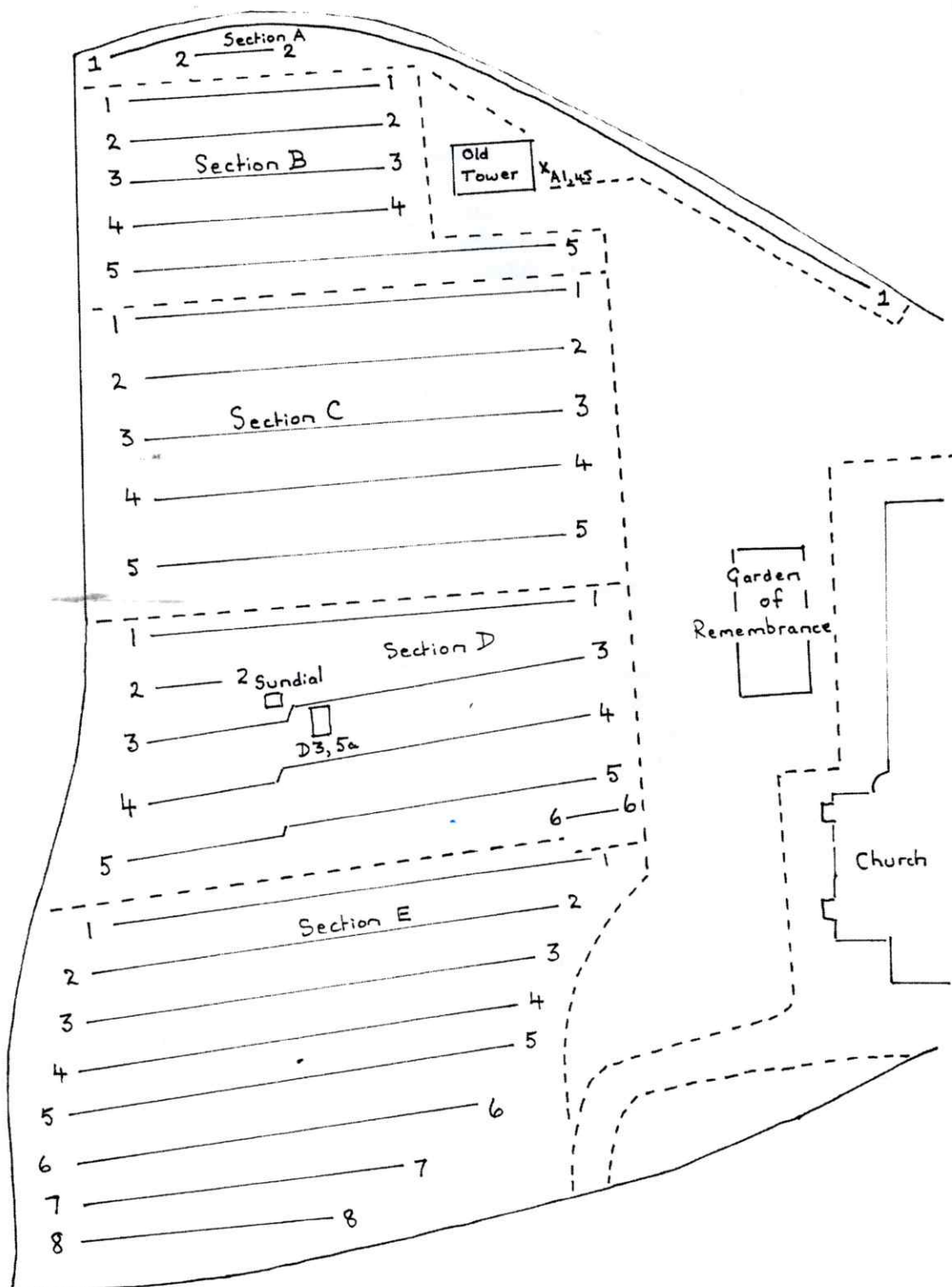
