

Here – and there

Reflecting on the global pandemic in the context of Jesus' journey to the cross



An opportunity to explore the challenges and changes to everyday life we have experienced during the pandemic within a biblical context.

Six scenes take us through Mark's account of Jesus' journey to the cross (chapters 14 and 15). Each scene makes a connection between 'here', our world today, and 'there', the world of the passion narrative. The connecting points are brought to life through voices talking about experiences in the pandemic, contrasted with a voice from a character in the Gospel.

Each week there will be:-

- Questions for conversation and reflection,
- An image,
- A prayer action,
- Music to listen to

The six scenes connect these themes and Bible passages:

Week 1 – 24th February

Healing presence – Simon's house, Mark 14.3-9

Week 2 – 3rd March

Provision – the upper room, Mark 14.17-25

Week 3 – 10th March

Isolation – the garden of Gethsemane, Mark 14.32-42

Week 4 – 17th March

Living with tension – the courtyard, Mark 15.6-15

Week 5 – 24th March

Anguish – the cross, Mark 15.33-39

Week 6 – 31st March

Hope – the tomb, Mark 15.42-47
