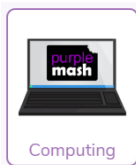


Dear Parents,

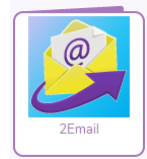

1. Each teacher will send out a weekly email to their class using the 2email app.

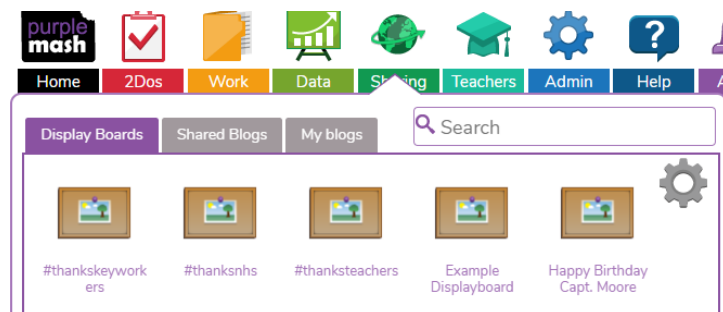


This can be accessed through the 'computing' section on their home page.

We would like the children to reply to the email as one of their weekly tasks. They can also use this app to send an email to their teacher to ask any questions they might have about their work. For safeguarding reasons, pupils can not send emails to other pupils.



2. At the top of the home screen there is a tab called 'sharing' and within that there is a section called 'displayboards.' This can be used to share good examples of work submitted by the children so their friends can see what they have been doing. Each phase will set up a displayboard this week using work from their 2dos.
