LEARNING

Maths - this week Years 1 and 2 have been shown how to use NumBots to develop their Maths skills. NumBots is an online game (also available as an app) that helps to improve rapid recall of number bonds, addition facts and subtraction facts. It is designed to become more difficult the more it is played. There are many levels to unlock. Children can earn coins that they 'spend' in the Custom Shack and as a result change the look of their robot. Log ins have been glued in the back of each child's reading record. Please have a go and see your child's teacher if you have any issues. Playing NumBots will now be part of the weekly homework so please play the game at least once a week.
