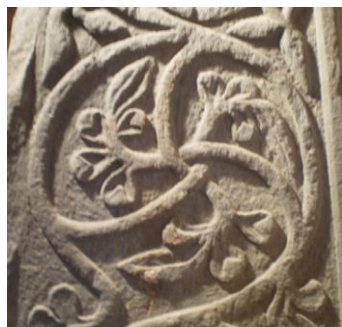

Week commencing: 30th May 2021 Trinity Sunday, Parish Communion

This Sunday our 10 am Holy Communion service is both in church and on zoom. The telephone line has been mended, so the zoom quality should be much better.

Just a reminder that if you have any spare hard copies of the order of service at home, please could you return them to church as they are disappearing at a rapid rate and we cannot justify printing more each week on both cost and environmental grounds.
