Last week Joshua and the Israelites were thankful. It had been a long journey to the Promised Land. But now they were here and getting ready to go in, the question was, how?



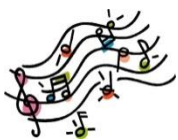
Today's reading isn't very long, but it's an important time for Joshua. Who meets the Commander of the Lord's army?
