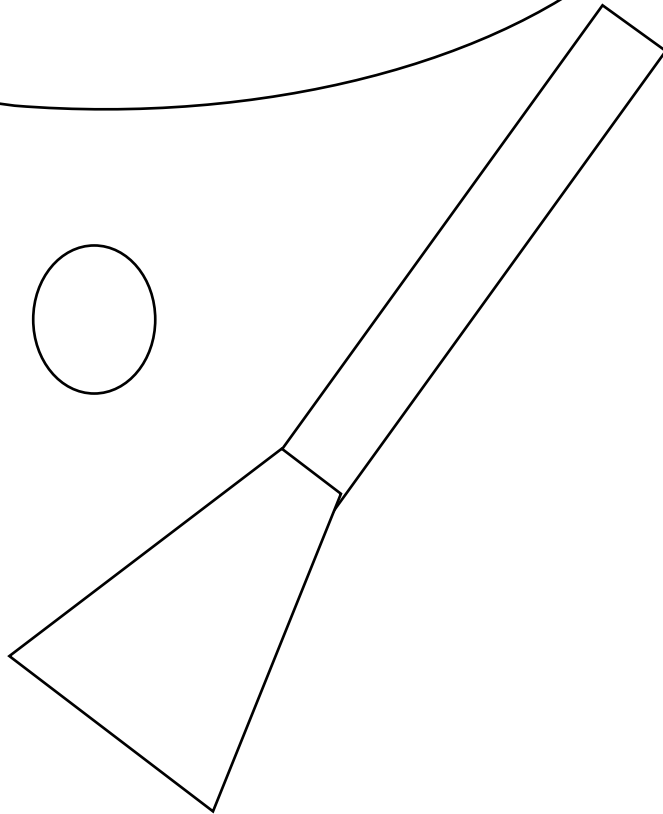


Parable of the Lost Coin

⁸ "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins^[a] and loses one. Won't she light a lamp and sweep the entire house and search carefully until she finds it? ⁹ And when she finds it, she will call in her friends and neighbours and say, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost coin.' ¹⁰ In the same way, there is joy in the presence of God's angels when even one sinner repents."



Print template onto white paper.

Colour in broom and coin, cut out the 3 elements.

Using an A4 coloured paper – fold paper in half, then unfold.

On the top half glue, the story of the Lost Coin.

Next cut thin strips on the wide end of the broom to give a brush effect.

Glue down the coin, the glue the handle of the brush so the brush part covers the coin.
